Remember the wool sculpture we had way back in January? Fun, wasn't it? We started the year with sculpture and we're going to close the year with it, this time with clay.

Some of you already know this artist. If you have never met her, you're in for a treat. Marianne de Hatten Groh is a petite bundle of French fun. Growing up in France, her eye was nourished on the greatest art in the world. She's been sculpting since her teens.

When Santa Cruz has Open Studios next spring, it is definitely worth the drive to visit her studio which is just a block from the beach. Her home/studio is as charming as she is -- and she has great food!

You'll see lots of beautiful dancers in her studio, especially ballerinas. But she does other human and animal figures in bronze, silver and terra cotta. Her work ranges from table-top to life size. Be sure to bring your wallet because I guarantee you will love her colorful free-form plates and bowls.

She is an award winning artist and calls her passion for sculpture "Le Feu Sacre...the fire within..." For her, she says, art "has been a lifetime process, always renewed by a never-ending enthusiasm." Her enthusiasm is quite contagious. Come and catch it yourself on November 1.

Marianne has workshops in Mexico, France and Santa Cruz. I'm sure she'll let you get your hands into the clay if you want to try it out. If you get hooked on it you may be able to get into her class that meets in Willow Glen.
